

## Commissioners Meeting 10/22/25

**Topic:** Spring 2026 boy's and girl's divisions

### Boys Division 1

It was agreed that Royal Irish should be relegated to Division 2 with Brownsburg being promoted. All other division teams are to remain the same as in 25.

### Boys Division 2

It was agreed that the division 2 boy's teams should be split into three pools. There would be a north, central and south pool consisting of the following teams.

**North:** Carroll Chargers, Homestead, Leo, Marrion, and Warsaw. It was noted that Leo has been struggling with numbers and may end up joining Bishop Dwenger.

**Central:** Carmel, City Center, North Central, Noblesville and Royal Irish.

**South:** Columbus, Louisville, Westside and Zionsville.

Austin to reach out to Zionsville to confirm if they would be willing to join the south pool in order to allow better travel for City and North Central.

It was agreed that the top two on points in each pool should advance to the state playoffs with the top two teams based on points to get a bye in the first round. The bottom 8 teams would be placed into the challenge cup. Ranking to be based on pool points, points difference and if necessary head-to-head results.

### Girls Division 1

It was agreed that Mudsocks and as requested by them Noblesville will be relegated to division 2. With Westfield and Zionsville being promoted. It is suggested that Zionsville be contacted to confirm their wish to be promoted. All other teams to remain in Division 1 as in 25

### Girls Division 2

I requested on behalf of Warsaw that their JV team be scheduled to play games in Division 2. As having a large squad it's difficult for them to get playing time for all of the girls. Especially as most other girl's teams have only 20 or so players. The JV team would not be part of the end of season championships nor have any effect on divisional ranking. This was agreed by the other three commissioners present.
